



Important Charter/Event Information

Guest Count for "All Inclusives"

We require an advanced guest count guarantee for All Inclusive charters 14 days prior to your cruise date. This number is your minimum charge. Any additional guests should be called in to our office no later than 3 days prior to your cruise date.

Setup/Boarding Policy

A list of all personnel requesting early boarding for catering and boat setup must be provided to the Patriot in writing with a time of arrival. Please note that all persons on the vessel will be asked to leave 15 minutes before scheduled boarding time for a vessel inspection by the Captain.

Final Payment

The balance of all charges is due seven (7) business days prior to the cruise. Payments must be made in the form of cash or check. Additional services provided while underway are payable at the time of request.

Cancellations

If you must cancel less than sixty (60) days prior to your event, any deposit that was made will be refunded only if we are able to rebook the vessel for that particular date and time. A \$150 handling fee will be charged to cancel cruises with a signed contract. If we fail to begin the cruise for any reason beyond our control, the cruise will be rescheduled or the event will continue dockside. If we are late in starting the cruise due to our actions, the cruise will be extended an equal amount of time. Patriot Cruises cannot be held responsible for extraordinary occurrences beyond our control which may interfere with your scheduled cruise. If we are required to totally cancel your charter, prior to embarking, for any reason which is not your fault, all funds paid will be completely refunded.

Outside Caterers

You are welcome to choose your caterer but a fee of \$350.00 is charged to use a caterer not on The Patriot's recommended list.

Food and Beverage

No food or beverage is to be brought on board without the permission by the Patriot Office. Under no circumstances are alcoholic beverages allowed to be brought on the vessel at any time due to State Liquor laws.

Open Bottle, Cash and Tab Bars

The Patriot will provide liquor and setups on an open bottle basis. We will provide a fee schedule for all wine, liquor, soda and setups and only charge for bottles opened. All opened and partially consumed bottles will be provided to the customer at the end of the cruise. Cash or tab bars are also an option. A gratuity of 20% will be charged for all Open Bottle or Tab Bar charges.

Alcohol

Anyone under the age of 21 found consuming alcoholic beverages and those contributing to their consumption will be returned to the dock immediately. Bartenders have the authority to withhold alcohol from anyone they feel is exceeding normal consumption.

Embarking/Disembarking

An additional fee will be charged for pick-up and drop-off at any location other than the home port of the Patriot

Entertainment

Entertainment is allowed on the lower deck only, unless prior permission has been given.

Smoking

Smoking is allowed only on the open areas of the upper deck.

Illegal Drugs

USCG Zero Tolerance=Termination of charter.

Authority

The Captain has complete authority aboard the vessel at all times.
